### Highland

This vast area of Scotland means that its whiskies come in many shapes and forms, the northern whiskies tend to be fuller with cereal notes as opposed to the southern whiskies with characteristic notes of fruit but tend to be drier. The Eastern highlands offers a combination of both the fruitiness of the north with the dryness of the south and the west does it their way with hints of smoke and peat to set its self apart from his neighbours.

### Lowland

The most gentle of whiskies come from the lowlands, these peaceful drams tend to be more delicate and floral. We are starting to see some of the closed distilleries from the Lowlands slowly re open as many were famed for their outstanding qualities, Today some are even starting to look at peat and casks to enhance those softer notes taking these whiskies to a different level.

Well known as being the powerful whiskies with a lot of peat used to enhance the whiskies. Some use this sparingly to create softer versions with less potency. Some have found a good balance between the peat and sweetness but maybe try one of these whiskies with food cooked on the tandoor to see how that peatiness works with the food.

### Island & Campbeltown

Island whiskies are each to their own varying in characteristics from some have costal expressions with the hints of sea air others heather becomes abundant with hints of smokiness. The terroir of the land shows through in these whiskies where it be from the land sky or earth makes these whiskies truly unique. Campbeltown are often known for their dry pungent whiskies, this area is slowly coming back after the US prohibition affected the area.

### Rest of the world

The rest of the world has caught onto the world of whiskies either from American with the softer, sweeter style of whiskies or from Japan whether they use their own malt but use Scottish techniques to ensure quality. Then to India whether the local conditions speed up the maturation process as much as 4 times the speed to create stunning whiskies with bags of flavour compare with a single malt to see the difference.

#### Fish Pakoda with Dalwhinnie 15yr

We then have the Pakoda which will go well with the softer style Dalwhinnie 15yr. The soft floral notes complete the natural sweetness of the fish.

#### Tibet Ghumma Lamb Sausage with Laphroaig Triple Wood

The powerful lamb sausage will be well matched with the smoky Triple wood with underlying spice and fruit tones to complement this red meat dish.

NV – Made by prestigious Le Colture family estate, this hand-made sparkling rose wine is the perfect party pink!

**Ridgeview, Sussex, England**  
NV – Crisp with citrus fruit aromas with hints of melon and honey. The Pinots add depth and character leading to a beautifully balanced finish.

## CHAMPAGNE

**Taittinger Brut La Francaise, Reims**  
NV – Light, fresh and balanced with a green fruit and citrus character rounded by subtle hints of biscuit and brioche on the palate.

2017 – A typical Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with cut grass aromas, gooseberry flavours and refreshing citric acidity.

2017 – An intense, concentrated Grüner, with stunning fruit flavours and beautifully balanced acidity.
